- The questions, the radio button groups, and the error messages are not programmatically associated. (WCAG 1.3.1, 3.3.2, 4.1.2)
- There are errors in the technical implementation which may cause issues with assistive technologies. (WCAG 4.1.1)

An effort will be made to correct the shortcomings listed in this statement during 2022.

How have we tested accessibility?

The observations in this accessibility statement are based on a third-party assessment of whether the online service meets legal requirements.
